- 3. International entries are welcome but all entries must be in English.
- 4. Under no circumstances can alterations be submitted once poems have been entered.
- The judges' decision is final and neither the judges nor Cannon Poets will enter into any correspondence.
- 6. No person involved in the judging process is eligible to enter the Competition.
- 7. No entrant may win more than one prize.

POEMS

- 8. There is no limit on the number of entries a single entrant can make.
- 9. Entries will not be returned, so please keep a copy.
- 10. All entries are judged anonymously and the poet's name must not appear on the poem itself.
- 11. All poems must have a title and must not exceed 14 lines (excluding title).
- 12. Entries can be on any subject.
- 13. Poems must be the original work of the entrant.
